Vaccinations & Wearing Masks

KSCL is mandating that anyone entering our premises OR residences, in all our service areas, who are 12 yrs and older, **must wear a mask, UNLESS you are double vaccinated.**

Due to the increase in COVID-19 cases in the Interior Health, we have no choice, but to mandate this policy to ensure the safety of our Employees and those who are choosing to have services.

We are not out of the Pandemic, and as long as people choose to not vaccinate, we will continue to see the virus spread.

Approximately 26.2% of British Columbians in Interior Health remain unvaccinated and **97% of all COVID-19 cases recorded up to July 15,2021 are UN-Vaccinated people in B.C. Please do your part and VAX for BC.**
